Find herewith final arrangements and information for the start of the Target Life year 2023:

### Reception of students at Kick-Start Camp:

- **Sunday 22 January 2023**
- **Place:** "Woord in Aksie, Derdepoort, Roodeplaat" campgrounds (North of Pretoria: GPS L - 25.67105 L - 28.29682)
- **Registration Starts:** 08:00-09:30
- **Briefing:** 09:30-11:30 ( For students and parents)
- **Greeting:** 11:30-11:45(Parents and students greet and the parents leave)

### Registration Requirements: (Only applicable if we have not received it via e-mail)

1. Your signed legal contract initialled on each page by ALL undersigned parties
2. Your signed legal lease agreement initialled on each page by ALL undersigned parties (if applicable)
- 3 Outstanding application documents (Application Form, copies of ID's, medical aid card)

### Kick-Start Camp:

"Kick-start" camp runs from 22 January 2022 - 25 January 2023.

**Transport:** Students are required to arrange self-transport (parents) to the camp grounds on 22 January at 08:00.

25 January, all students will travel back together in arranged busses. We will arrive at Living Word church grounds around 15:00.

It is **compulsory** for all students to come back with the bus, and therefore students are **not allowed to go to the campsite with their own cars.**

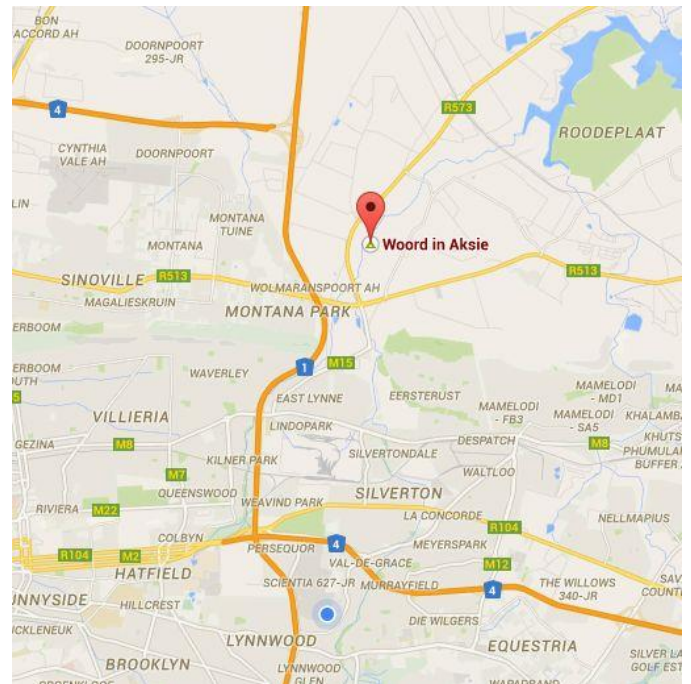
If parents will not be going with to the campsite and/or transport is required, you need to arrange it with Taryn, 079 516 1063, **before Thursday 19 January 18:00.**

### **What to bring:**

- 1 Set of old clothes
- 3 Sets of comfortable clothes for 3 days (T-shirts and shorts)
- Warm Clothes
- Swimwear, swimming towel and sunscreen
- Toiletries and bath towel
- Sleepwear, sleeping bag and pillow
- A pen
- Snacks

### **What NOT to Bring:**

- Your cell phone is NOT allowed
- You do not need cutlery and crockery



## **Commune Arrangements**

Students may move in Friday 20 or Saturday 21 January between 09:00 - 18:00.

### **What to bring:**

1. Cutlery and crockery: Plate, knife, forks, a glass, a coffee mug etc. *Pots and pans are provided*
2. Dish cloth, sponge and drying cloth (x3)
3. Washing pegs, washing powder (Automatic machines) and softener
4. Marking pen to mark your things
5. Toiletries and own facecloths/sponges and towels
6. Bedding for a single bed.
7. Own Iron (Optional)
8. **Food:** Remember, grocery space is limited.
9. Board games etc. (optional)
10. PC or laptop (optional and may only be used in the communal area.)
11. Small music instruments
12. Car, motorbike or bicycle (Optional)
13. NO animals or insects
14. NO alcohol, electronic/ normal cigarettes or any drugs (Weed included)

### **Optional:**

1. Bar fridge/Small fridge (For bedroom)
2. Own single-bed mattress
